Half Day

Which beach is it on?

Our beach is on the amazing blue flag beach of Rest Bay in Porthcawl, Bridgend County Borough Council where we have our main base. Rest Bay is easy to access off the M4 and offers both a sandy and rocky shore for studies.

Other beaches - that we have licences for - can be used on request. Please ask.

Is there shelter?

Yes. Whilst all the activities are delivered outdoors on the beach - whatever the weather we understand that respite may be needed from the weather to eat lunches etc. We have 2 large beach bell tents and access to an indoor first floor room at Rest Bay Football Club which is booked for your visit just in case.

Is there anywhere to sit for lunch apart from the beach?

Yes. We have many large picnic benches outside our unit at the Watersports Centre which you have priority of use during your booked visit.

Can we spend pocket money?

Yes. Beach Academy has a small shop at Rest Bay Watersports Centre packed with marine equipment and gifts. All money raised goes to continue our educational work connecting kids to the shore.

How many pupils can we bring?

As many as you like! We will organisee beach teachers for your day dependendent on your chosen activities and pupil numbers. Leave it to us to organise the day, just tell us how many are coming.

Is there a beach wheelchair?

Yes. There is a beach wheelchair that can be booked. Please make us aware that you will need it. The beach is also wheelchair friendly with good access to the beach via the slip.

Does it matter what age the children are?

No. We can accommodate any age and have beach teachers that have specialist age groups. We do make suggestions you may want to consider when choosing your activities based on difficulty and understanding levels.

Are any actvities free?

Yes. We have many projects going on at one time and many projects are funded and offered free to schools and community groups. Please ask us for an up-to-date project list.

Do activities go ahead in the rain?

Yes, marine animals don't mind water, neither do we! Dress appropriately and if the weather is very very bad we will contact you to rearrange. This is very rare and only in extreme cases.

Are you just a summer thing?

Absolutely not. Beach Academy runs year round and each season brings its own wonders on the coast.

Do we have to take our bags to the beach?

No, if you'd rather we can lock them up in our shop and you can access them after your activity.

OUTREACH

WE COME TO YOU...

We understand you may not be able to make it to the beach for many reasons, the cost of coaches being a main reason. But why miss out? Our teaching team - all qualified teachers - can come to your school with specialist outreach workshops linked to Curriculum for Wales for any age group.

HOW IT WORKS...

We run one type of workshop per day. (e.g. cannot have rockpool school in the morning and plastic pollution in the afternoon)

In that day we can accommodate 2 classes. One before and one after lunch. Age or year group up to the school and times to suit school timetable

Our beach teacher come to your school. We are all about learning in the great outdoors so that will always be our first option (playground, outdoor learning area, school fields etc) However being Wales please make sure that if the weather is not nice, we can have a space indoors to set up as an alternative, such as hall or classroom.

LIVING THINGS - Rockpool School
